- The consultative forums, which were part of a five-year project called "Triangular Cooperation on Sustainable Development in the Lower Mekong Basin based on the Water-Energy-Food (WEF) Nexus, had the aims to inspect a potential pilot site in each country and discuss implementation structures with key stakeholders.
- The forums were held in Viet Nam on September 22-23, 2022, in Cambodia on October 20-21, 2022, and in Lao PDR on October 25-26, 2022. Read more.
