MI, Republic of Korea Lead Meeting of Technical Working Group on Green Freight and Logistics Development Project

Members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) of the project on *Green Freight and Logistics Development in Mekong Countries* convened at MI on March 8, 2018 for their 1st TWG Meeting. Twelve delegates from government agencies from Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Vietnam and Thailand, as well as representatives from the German Agency for International Cooperation and the private sector including freight and transport associations, attended the meeting.

RLED-EWEC Project Holds Consultation Workshops in Lao PDR, Vietnam

The first in a series of consultation workshops on the in-depth study on crossborder trade facilitation on agricultural products and inputs was organized in Quang Tri province, Vietnam on March 13, 2018. The workshop, delivered in cooperation with the Quang Tri Provincial People's Committee, shared the initial findings of the study to leaders and representatives of provincial authorities and agencies as well as businesses of the twin provinces of Quang Tri (Vietnam) and Savannakhet (Lao PDR).

The second workshop was held in Khammouane, Lao PDR on March 15. In attendance were representatives from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Lao PDR; participants from the government and private sectors of Khammouane, Savannakhet, and Champasak provinces in Lao PDR; and Nakhon Phanom and Mukdahan provinces in Thailand.

Both workshops, organized by the EWEC Vietnam and EWEC Lao field offices, respectively, allowed the participants to forward their comments on the findings as well as prioritize and discuss action plans with specific interventions. A debriefing workshop at MI followed on March 16 wherein the results and initial actions plans were presented to the MI management team.

MI Supports Business to Business Meeting on CBTF

MI through the RLED-EWEC project, provided support in the organization of a round-table meeting on cross-border trade facilitation on March 10, 2018 in Savannakhet, Lao PDR. Present at the event were representatives of business associations from the provinces of Savannakhet, Mukdahan (Thailand) and Quang Tri (Vietnam). The meeting enabled business associations to exchange issues and propose alternatives at the policy level to facilitate cross-border trade along the EWEC particularly among the three provinces. This will be followed by an enterprise meeting to concretize the proposal for a business to government dialogue.

EWEC Myanmar Carries Out Survey on Contract Farming

The EWEC Myanmar Field Office, in collaboration with Mya Hta Kywe Linn Company, Bio-Supreme Input Company and Myanmar Corn Farmers' Association, carried out a detailed survey on contract farming in 10 potential villages of Myawaddy last February 14-16, 2018. The team identified interested farmers and collected information on their acreage, variety of seeds, soil type, as well as clarified the dates for the delivery of farming inputs. Mya Htay Kywe Linn Company Managing Director U Saw Than Mya also clarified the process of accessing loan.

Preparations for Contract Farming for Upcoming Season On Track

Following the farmer surveys, the EWEC Myanmar team and partners, Bio-Supreme Company, Mya Htay Kywe Lin and Myanmar Corn Farmers' Association met on February 28 to discuss further preparations for contract farming for the upcoming season. The groups clarified the implementation in the selected villages, including the amount and variety of inputs, number of demonstration plots, floor price, and the related trainings on fertilizer application and cost-effective production. In another meeting with Mya Htay Kywe Lin Company and technicians from Ye Tun Industry on March 3, the team also discussed the drying facility to be provided to the farmer groups.

MI, SDC Visit Myanmar Project Sites

The MI team led by Dr. Watcharas Leelawath, Executive Director, and Ms. Barbara Jäggi Hasler, Deputy Director of Cooperation and Head of Domain Employment and Skills of the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation in Lao PDR, visited the Myanmar project sites on March 26-29, 2018. The group checked on the project's progress and discussed achievements, opportunities and challenges with local authorities, the private sector and project beneficiaries from Myawaddy and Hpa-an townships. On the last day, the group observed the export/import inspection system in the trade zone of Myawaddy.

MI Attends Meeting of Working Group on Water Resources of Lancang-Mekong Cooperation

Ms. Jutamas Thongcharoen, Program Manager at Agricultural Development and Commercialization Department, attended the 2nd Meeting of the Joint Working Group on Water Resources of Lancang-Mekong Cooperation on March 1, 2018 in Chiang Rai, Thailand. Ms. Thongcharoen introduced MI's project with the Department of Water Resources, Ministry of National Resources and Environment on Transboundary Cooperation Mechanism on Adaptation to Climate Change and Hydropower Development that is expected to start in May this year.

MI Takes Active Role in Regional CBTA Work

Leveraging on its expertise in trade facilitation and logistics and transport management, MI has been tapped to develop the approach for the monitoring and evaluation of the early harvest implementation on cross-border trade facilitation agreement (CBTA). Dr. Watcharas Leelawath, together with Mr. Madhurjya Kumar Dutta, Director of Trade and Investment Facilitation (TIF) Department and Mr. Quan Anh Nguyen, TIF Program Specialist, presented the M&E approach of the MoU implementation during the joint committee meeting arranged by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) on March 14-15 in Hanoi, Vietnam.

MI-IDRC Projects Presented in IDRC Conference

Mr. Madhurjya Kumar Dutta, TIF Director, joined the 4th Canada ASEAN Business Forum and the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) Conference on March 21-23, 2018 in Singapore.
