#### Savannakhet—Mukdahan—Quang Tri Business Sectors Converge for B<sub>2</sub>B Meeting

A Business to Business (B2B) meeting was held among the business sectors of Savannakhet, Lao PDR; Mukdahan, Thailand and Quang Tri, Vietnam on June 14 in Savannakhet Province. The B2B aimed to update the business representatives on the progress of the action plan implementation by the provincial governments following the first Business to Government (B2G) dialogue in Mukdahan last year, as well as share pending and emerging issue on cross-border trade activities and corresponding solutions. ### MI Co-organizes EWEC Business Forum

MI co-organized the recently-held EWEC Business Forum with the Mukdahan Commercial Affairs Office as a step to further promote cross-border trade and investment in the economic corridor. Held on June 26-27 in Mukdahan, Thailand, 180 government oficers and entrepreneurs from provinces along the EWEC namely, Quang Binh and Quang Tri (Vietnam), Khammouane and Savannakhet (Lao PDR), Myawaddy (Myanmar), as well as provinces from north and northeaster regions of Thailand, joined the event. ### Farmers, Bio-Supreme Input Company **Discuss Contract Agreements**

EWEC Myanmar facilitated the meeting between Bio-Supreme Input Company and farmers from northern Myawaddy last June 18. During the meeting, the company agreed to reduce the price of fertilizers and to postponing the repayment time of the farmers who were affected by the flooding in 2018. The farmers also requested for a group loan for their 2019 season.

# New Demo Farms Established with Enterprise Partner in Myawaddy

Eleven demo farms were set up as part of the new cooperation agreement with Mar Lar Myaing Company. Totaling 22 acres, the farms were set up in 11 villages to help farmers compare the net benefit of using local and Thai fertilizers. On June 16, the EWEC Myanmar Office facilitated the meeting wherein funds and inputs were transferred from the company to the farmers.



# Rubber and Pepper Farmers Form Groups, linked with SMEs

This month, two new rubber farmer groups and pepper farmer groups were formed through the support of Ml's EWEC Project, the Quang Tri Trading Corporation and Quang Tri Subdepartment of Rural Development. Following their formation, some 30 members of the Tan Phy farmer group were linked with Cam Lo Rubber Company, while about 107 members of two pepper groups were matched with Dong Ha Agriculture Product Company. The business matching will help eliminate middlemen and allow farmers to sell their products in bulk direct to companies and increase their income.

# EWEC Vietnam Leads Review Workshop on 2018 Rubber Production

The EWEC Vietnam Office hosted 37 participants from local government authorities, banks and rubber enterprises and rubber farmer groups in a workshop to review the results of the 2018 rubber production including business transactions between farmer groups and enterprises and farmer group operations. Held on June 4-5 in Cua Viet township in Quang Tri, farmer groups shared pending issues while local authorities and enterprises provided updated information on policies supporting farmer groups and agriculture cooperative. The workshop resulted with the development of an agreed joint plan of action for the 2019 crop review.



# Project Coffee Farmers Join Coffee Roasting Training

The RLED-EWEC Project supported the participation of representatives from two coffee mini-processors in Huong Hoa in a three-day training on coffee roasting in Ho Chi Minh City. The training shared techniques on product processing, which they can further use to support coffee farmer groups,.



### MI Speaks at Seminar on SEZ Development

MI Executive Director Dr. Watcharas Leelawath served as one of the speakers in the seminar on *Special Economic Zone Development for Trade, Investment and Tourism* on June 27-30 in Chiang Rai, Thailand. Organized by the District Office of Chiang Khong, Department of Provincial Administration, and the International Institute for Trade and Development, the seminar aimed to enhance cross-border special economic zone development to support GMS logistics development. Dr. Watcharas talked about the initiatives of MI geared towards promoting connectivity and cross-border trading in GMS economic gateways.
