Policy Dialogue on Cross-border Trade Facilitation

The EWEC Project facilitated a policy dialogue on cross-border trade facilitation between Quang Tri Province of Vietnam and Savannakhet Province of Lao PDR on October 28, 2016 in Sepon District, Savannakhet Province. The dialogue focused on the findings and recommendations of a research project conducted by MI in 2015 on agricultural commodities at the border crossing of Lao Bao and Dansavan, as well as the need for policy adjustments on both sides. Final Training on Integrated Pest Management (IPM)



The last of a series of trainings on Integrated Pest Management (IPM) was conducted on October 10-12, 2016 in three Districts in Khammouane, Lao PDR. A total of 81 farmers and officers from DAFO joined the training which was provided by a team from PAFO. The objective of the final training was to summarize the topics covered in IPM and evaluate what the participants have learned.

Promoting Rice Seed Production, GAP and GMP Standard Application

On October 11-12, the Lao Star TV channel interviewed four GAP groups, two rice millers (Vanida and Soulivan rice mills) who have applied GMP standard application, one rice seed producing group, and the project team leader in Khammouane province. Structured Learning Visit to Shan State



An SLV was organized to Yat Sot, Shan State on October 12-16, 2016 for Myawaddy maize growing farmers to learn cultivation practices and effective crop maintenance. The farmers also learned about the production of hybrid maize seed and organic fertilizer, as well as how to use a maize harvest as a planter tool. A total of 25 farmers from the project areas and two DOA staffs from Myawaddy joined the SLV.
