

4. Duration and Location

The Capacity Building Trajectory contains three phases, i.e.

• Phase I: 30 October – 3 November 2023

One-week face-to-face training workshop on Monitoring & Evaluation at the Mekong Institute

• Phase II: 7 November – 22 December 2023

An online opening and closing workshop and a series of weekly meetings (1 hr each) with each of the 7 thematic project teams.

• Phase III: 15 – 16 January 2024

An online, or potentially face-to-face in Khon Kaen, validation workshop to discuss the "MKCF Consolidated Regional M&E Framework" with stakeholders from the Korean Government, Mekong Institute, and the project managers.

The tentative schedule for the full capacity building trajectory will be as follows:

17 – 27 Oct 2023	Pre-training preparation	 Assessment of participants knowledge and skills through an online questionnaire; Distribution of online training outline and content by MI Organizing Team; Testing the online training application with all participants;
30 Oct – 3 Nov 2023	Live training at Mekong Institute	7.5 hours per day, 5 days Presentations, group work, interactive sessions, simulation exercises, quizzes, discussions and questions and answers (Q&A) may be applied during the live sessions in line with the objectives of related training sessions according to the training methods designed by resource persons.

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7 Nov – 22 Dec 2023	Full group online opening and closing session, Online thematic group work among the participants	 Thematic sector groups will be formed, and assignments will be explained during online opening live sessions, and weekly thematic sector group meetings with consultant and MI Organizing Team; Groups may choose their appropriate methods of communication and agree upon time either online or offline for discussions among themselves; MI Team will monitor group activities.
15 / 16 Jan 2024	Group presentations during live validation meeting	 Each group may be allotted some time per week for presentations, discussions and Q&A Members of other groups will attend group presentations.
